No.NBE-21/Ad-RMSA/2017-18 :: It is hereby notified for information that the National Achievement Survey Class X (Cycle 2) 2018 under RMSA is to be conducted on **5<sup>th</sup> February 2018** across the Country. This survey is being coordinated by the Educational Survey Division of the NCERT.

The National Achievement Survey (NAS) are representative sample of schools from all districts in India aimed at understanding the health of the education system in government, government aided and private schools. Findings from the NAS are used as inputs in policy, planning and pedagogical interventions to improve the student learning outcomes.

In Nagaland, 426 (four hundred twenty six) sampled schools in Nagaland will be participating in this nationwide Survey. **On 5<sup>th</sup> February 2018, the survey will begin at 10:00 a.m.** in all the sampled schools. Respective District Education officer (DEO)/Sub-Divisional Education Officer (SDEO) shall hand over the test materials to the head of the sampled schools at least 3(three) days ahead of the dates of test administration.
