IMPORTANT

- All Schools must have email address.
- 2. Schools should visit the Board's website for getting important notifications issued by the Board.
- 3. Schools are advised not to wait for the LAST day for collection or submission.
- 4. Schools should carefully check the dates mentioned here or any dates specified separately for any collection or submission of forms.
- 5. The penalty for failure to submit forms and fees on the specified dates is a fine of `30,000/-
- 6. All General holidays indicated in the State Govt. Calendar are to be observed as State/National holidays compulsorily.
- 7. The 1st and 3rd Saturdays of the month are to be utilized for tests/co-curricular activities/Life skills/social works etc.
- 8. Cleanliness drive in the schools should be carried out on regular basis.
- 9. Inspection/visit will be carried out by the Board's Officials at any time of the academic year.
- 10. In case of any change in the dates specified above, it shall be notified to the schools.
- 11. Schools must inform the Board in written (along with relevant documents such as appointment order & educational documents and transfer order) as and when new Headmaster/Headmistress is appointed.
- 12. All registered school should conduct coaching/preparatory classes for HSLC candidates till 15th December every year.

- 1. Form nos. 3, can also be downloaded and submitted online to the address: nbseforms@gmail.com
- 2. CCE Report Card must be properly entered and kept in the school office for inspection/submission as and when asked for.
- 3. Academic report/Question paper observation report: The concerned subject teacher has to write in detail the topic coverage/question paper observation of each subject. This can also be **submitted online through the address:** nbseforms@qmail.com
- 4. Annual report, Observance reports of Teachers' Day, Environment Day, Children's Day, World AIDS Day, National Education Day, Swach Bharat, Swachhta Hi Sewa (the Swachhta Hi Sewa is a Pledge of the Nation to create a clean, healthy and new India which begins from 15 Sept. 2nd Oct. every year) etc. can also be submitted online through the address **nbsenag@gmail.com**
- 5. The head of the school can send a responsible teacher duly authorized by him/her for collection and submission of forms or documents. However, for collection of confidential packets, it shall be as per the rules.
- 6. All registered schools are expected to submit the enrolment and particulars of its students to the concerned DEO.
- 7. The examination fees for Class IX Final Examination shall be paid only by the schools/centre schools to the Board.
- 8. Failed centre repeaters shall pay a forwarding fee of \square 100/- to the Centre School during submission of forms.
- 9. The rate of examination fees are: Class IX ` 450/-, HSLC ` 900/-, HSLC (Compartmental)- ` 300/- per subject.
- 10. Class IX Registration fee is ` 200/- per student, but for migrating student of class IX & X, it is ` 850/- per student.
- 11. For submission of Application Forms for HSLC Examination 2020, refer "Rules and Regulations for filling up of Forms" for more details.
- 12. Fee structure for Class VIII will be informed later.

EXPLANATION:

- 1. Registered schools are high schools registered with the NBSE, which are recognised or permitted.
- 2. Recognised schools are those registered full-fledged high schools recognised by the NBSE.
- 3. Permitted schools are those high schools registered with the Board to open Class IX & X and are yet to get recognition.
- 4. Middle schools are schools having upto Class-VIII with the permission/recognition of Directorate of School Education.

INFORMATION

- Migrating students for admission in Class-IX & X as regular students should seek prior permission from the Board. Last date for receiving of application is **31-03-2019**.
